Jerry G. Llewellyn was born April 28, 1934, in Alpha, Iowa, the son of George and Alda E. (Trewin) Llewellyn. He graduated from Iowa Teachers College High School in 1952. He went on to serve his country in the U.S. Army from Nov. 6, 1956, to Nov. 5, 1958.

He married Sylvia Denholm on August 9, 1953, at Bethlehem Lutheran Church in Cedar Falls. He was with the Cedar Falls Fire Department for 37 years, retiring as chief (1986-1993) on July 3, 1993. He was past president of both the Cedar Falls Boat Club and the Main Street Social Club.
